Imagination Playground is child-centred and encourages self-expression through free play.

The playground is comprised of large blue foam bricks in a variety of shapes and sizes enabling children to transform their environment and create a play space of their own.

Come along and imagine, invent, collaborate and play. What will you build - a castle, a rocket, a tunnel, a den - the possibilities are endless. Go wild, let your imagination be your guide, and invent your own games in your space. There are no rules here for what you create!

Stardust is an interactive environment which welcomes very young children and their grown-ups into a gentle, shapeshifting intergalactic landscape, full of intriguing music, sounds, and smells.

There are plenty of buttons to press and intriguing new colours and textures to explore, as well as chances to discover alien languages and astronaut footprints.

Stardust invites babies and toddlers to discover their universe in new ways, and gives them the power to change it.

This sensory journey into space is part of a programme of specially-commissioned play installations at The Hullabaloo.

About the Artists

Cloud Cuckoo Land are an interdisciplinary ensemble who put children at the heart of the story. They create warm, playful interactive performances and installations, jam-packed with live music, sensory surprises and technical wizardry. They transport audiences on magical flights of fancy to discover distant lands and new perspectives, celebrating their creativity and sense of fun.

Storm

by Bamboozle Theatre Company

Inspired by Shakespeare's The Tempest, Storm tells the story of the magician Prospero, his apprentice Ariel and the creature Caliban. Bamboozle's enchanting production has been carefully designed to accommodate a wide-ranging audience including those from across the autistic spectrum.

Using elements of The Tempest and a limited amount of Shakespeare's language, Storm tells a dramatic story of the sea, ships, islands and magic.

Audience members will be welcomed into the performance space with relaxing music and during the performance will be invited to interact with the actors and the setting. The production is designed to enable individuals to engage with the story in their own time and at their own pace.

Café Hullabaloo

Supported by members of Darlington Building Society

Open Monday - Saturday • 10am-2pm

Our family friendly café is situated in the main entrance of the venue. The café provides a vibrant and relaxing space to spend time with family and friends. Both the creative play spaces are accessed via the café and we also have a good library of story books for you to enjoy whilst relaxing in one of our comfy armchairs.

In the café you can access free wifi and enjoy a selection of light bites and hot and cold beverages. There are also plenty of high chairs on offer and easy access to toilets, to a buggy park and baby change.

Outside of the above times the venue will open 30 minutes before a performance begins, and we only open on a Sunday when there is a performance.



Parking

The Hullabaloo does not have a car park. There are short and long stay off street car parks close by to the venue. Most Council car parks are covered by 24 hour CCTV surveillance. For further advice on parking please contact the Box Office, or visit the Darlington Borough Council website.

Access

We provide access for a range of special needs. If your particular needs are not met by those listed don't hesitate to give us a call and we'll be happy to accommodate you.

The Hullabaloo is accessed at ground level. We have room for a number of wheelchairs within the theatre space and Creative Play space and these are accessed on the ground floor.

The Rehearsal Room on the first floor has lift access. Unfortunately, wheelchair spaces for performances cannot be booked online; please contact the Box Office to book.

A dropped counter is available at The Hullabaloo Box Office and café. If booking tickets at Darlington Hippodrome for The Hullabaloo there is also a dropped counter at their Box Office.



BSL Interpreted Performances

British Sign Language (BSL) is integrated into the show for non-hearing audiences.



Hearing assist equipment

We have a radio frequency hearing system installed throughout the auditorium with individual headsets available on request when booking.



Relaxed Performances

The lights stay on, the audience can talk and leave and enter the auditorium. Specially designed for people with autism, a sensory or communication disorder, or anyone else who would find a typical theatre setting a challenging environment.
