To accompany your class trip to see FIVE, WinterWalker and Theatre Hullabaloo invite you to join the creative team and performers for an introduction to dance, movement, and the ideas in the show.

This practical session is designed to demystify contemporary dance and to explore ideas for using movement in the classroom to enrich other areas of learning.

INTRODUCING CONTEMPORARY DANCE:

The performers will show some material from FIVE, and there will be a brief presentation on how we make dance, with a discussion on ways to introduce it to your pupils.

EXPLORING THE FIVE SENSES THROUGH MOVEMENT:

FIVE explores the five senses in a fun, physical way. The dancers and creative team will share some ideas on how this could be used into classroom work, particularly in the areas of literacy and science. The team will lead activities to try with your class before and after the show; please wear loose, comfortable clothing if possible. No previous dance experience is required.
