On our adventure we will visit a waterfall.



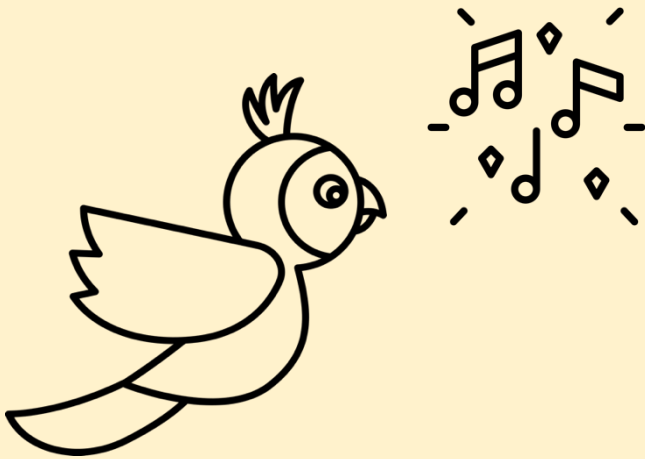
We will pretend that the fabric streamers are the waterfall. I can feel them if I like.
