At the heart of The Hullabaloo is our Creative Play space where babies, children and their grown-ups can play in for free together between 10am-2pm Monday - Saturday.

Join us in our brand new garden-like play space that invites little ones to explore, adventure, and grow vibrant ideas together with their grown-ups.

Lounge and snuggle, roll and dance, play and discover in this enchanting space where ideas can germinate, curiosity will grow new shoots and young minds develop as creativity blooms.

Made with the children and educators at Borough Road Nursery together with Theatre Hullabaloo artists and researchers, this creative play space has been shaped through research into how children and adults want to be together in creative spaces. It's designed as a gentle restorative space for babies, children and adults alike and has been particularly enjoyed by the SEND children at the nursery.

Dreamland is a beautiful sensory play installation in our creative play space designed for very young children aged 0-4 years and their grown-ups. The Hullabaloo in Darlington is the only purpose-built theatre for children and young people north of London. Situated on Borough Road, adjacent to Darlington Hippodrome, it is a special venue for children and families and an exciting place to play and learn.

At The Hullabaloo you will find world-class theatre made specially for children - including brilliant shows for babies and toddlers - free creative play installations, storytelling, socially prescribed play programmes and much more!

Although The Hullabaloo is always pretty chilled, we do have specific NDF Performances (open to everyone) where families with additional needs might feel more comfortable. At these:

- pre-show information is available to help you prepare for your visit
- you can peek into the theatre before the show begins
- getting up, moving around and responding in your own way to the show is absolutely fine

As always, The Hullabaloo was a fabulous venue. They're super inclusive and very aware of neurodiversity and additional needs.




