The play is about 50 minutes long, with no interval.

Before the play starts

When you arrive at the theatre, there are people at the front desk who can help you.

They can show you where the toilet is if you need it.



They will show you where to sit in the theatre to watch the play. If you need a quiet space they will show you where you can go.

We want you to feel comfortable and enjoy the play.



This means you can make noises if you need to, or wear headphones.

The Clown is also sometimes played by a puppet.

(And there are some chicken puppets too!)



There is music in the play to help us tell the story.

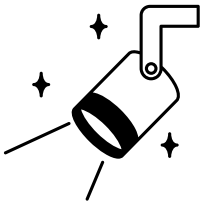


Some music you will hear from the speakers in the theatre.
