While The Hullabaloo is always relaxed, our NDF performances (open to everyone) offer extra support for families who may need it. At these performances:

- You'll receive pre-show information to help you prepare for your visit
- You can explore the theatre before the show begins
- Moving around and responding as you need to is absolutely fine
- Audience sizes are smaller for a calmer experience
- A safe, creative space is available if your child needs a break

15 min sessions between 10am & 4pm

Bathe in sound and light with your baby as you explore the wonders of how their senses develop. Sit, lie down or stand while sharing this immersive, intimate experience.

Inspired by research from The Sussex Baby Lab into the expanding vision of children from birth until 18 months, this 15-minute installation distills the world of awakening perception into a unique show. Real-life soundscapes harmonise and echo a newborn's hearing as lights twinkle and colour slowly fills the performance pod.

Co-commissioned by the Barbican London and developed with support from Attenborough Centre for the Creative Arts and Half Moon Theatre.


At Theatre Hullabaloo, we believe every child deserves magical, creative experiences that inspire imagination and joy.


Our venue offers a relaxed, welcoming atmosphere for everyone. With a family-friendly café, cosy story corner, outdoor play area, creative play space and studio theatre, it's the perfect place to unwind and enjoy time with friends and family.

Our café serves a selection of hot and cold drinks, along with light snacks - including gluten-free options. You'll find plenty of highchairs and comfortable seating to make your visit easy and enjoyable.
